- Demonstrated advanced proficiency in Mandarin Chinese (reading, writing, speaking, listening), native speaker preferred
- Bachelor's degree required, Master's degree in Chinese, teaching, or a related field preferred
- Secondary teaching experience required, independent school experience preferred

- Demonstrated ability and passion to work with diverse students, including those with varied learning styles
- Demonstrate ability to utilize varied teaching methods to accommodate students' unique learning styles and preferences
- Demonstrated ability to establish an inviting, exciting, and innovative learning environment for middle and upper school students
- Demonstrated experience with long- and short-term planning to address individual needs of students
- Demonstrated experience partnering effectively with parents, faculty members, and other influencers
- Demonstrated evidence of seeking feedback from students, supervisor and colleagues, and actively pursuing professional development opportunities
