Unique Features

- Through our "Open Circuit" framework (based on design thinking), 5th-day courses will allow students to incorporate community-based problem-solving skills to solve real-world problems while enhancing their project planning and executive functioning skills
- Our weekly "Wellspring" class helps students understand their social-emotional learning abilities, develop capacity for self-care, as well as cultivate stronger relationships with others

Advanced Placement

Enrollment is open for all AP courses.

Offered this year: Calculus AB, Computer Science A, English Language, English Literature, Environmental Science, Psychology, Microeconomics, and US History.

Other exams often taken: Art & Design, Art History, Biology, Physics 1, US Government and Politics, and World History: Modern.

From 2022-2025, Crossroads students sat for 183 exams in 21 different subjects. During this same period, 65% of 10th - 12th grade Crossroads students sat for at least one AP exam.
