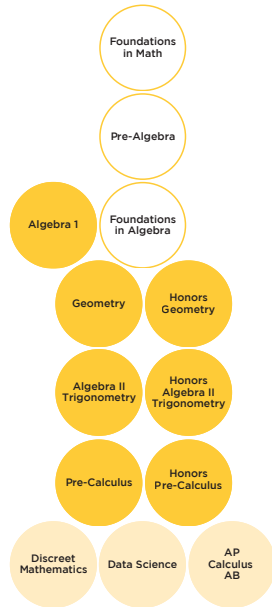


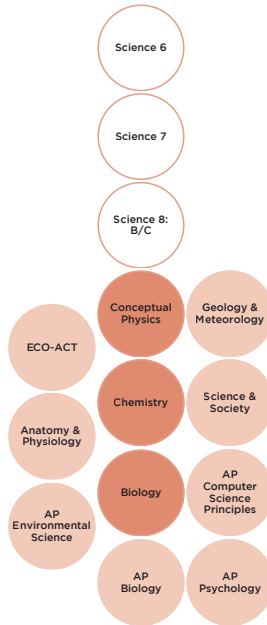
CURRICULUM MAP

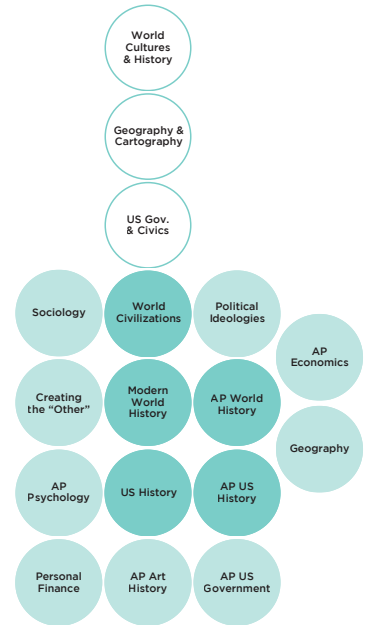

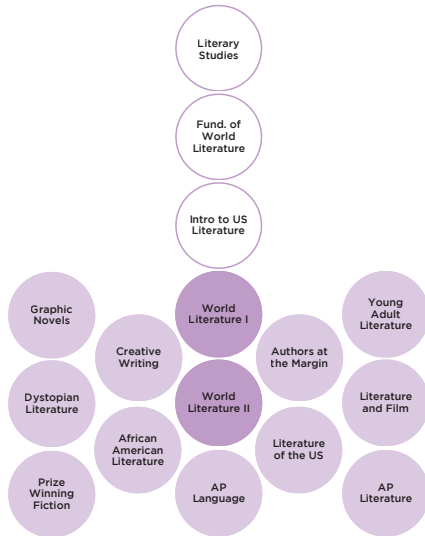

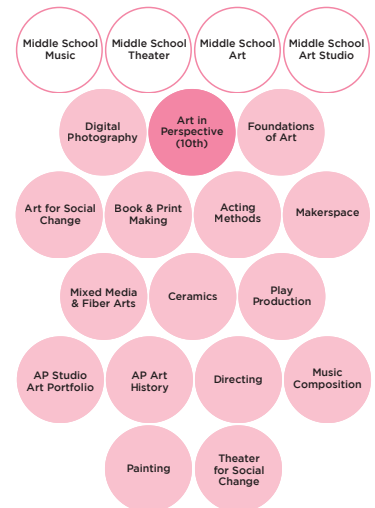
